Practical Solutions to Accelerate SDGs Progress

As the world nears the halfway point of the 2030 Agenda and continues to rebuild in the aftermath of the COVID-19 pandemic. Practical solutions that can accelerate progress on the SDGs will be desperately needed in this context. The focus will be on accelerating transformation through important entry points and enabling science to support this acceleration.

MTE 2023: SDG International Innovation Awards (SDGIIA) is the first in the region focused on recognizing innovations, initiatives, programmes and ideas which contribute to sustainability, eradicating poverty, improving well-being, protecting our planet, and building peace and prosperity.

The awards return on the 18–20 October 2023 and will be held virtually. In 2022, the awards received 217 innovation entries from Hong Kong, Philippines, Taiwan, Thailand, China, UK, US, Yemen, Arab Saudi, Indonesia, Iran, and Malaysia; with 186 entries shortlisted. 80 Gold, 58 Silver and 16 Bronze medals were awarded to participants who competed in 5 main categories, embracing all 17 SDGs. The event garnered 3011 trade visitors from 22 countries over the 5-day period.



Adopting evidence-based actions that can move progress forward at the global and local levels

A new report from the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, United States, identifies possible action steps that governments, nongovernmental and philanthropic organizations, universities, and the private sector can take to operationalize the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The priority research areas and action steps include:

All levels of education are uniquely positioned to operationalize sustainable development across society. Based on an institutional mission, universities could assist students and staff in evaluating needs and prioritising among SDGs.

Localization of the SDGs and indigenous knowledge networks

Federal and local governments could collaborate to promote resilient and sustainable supply chains in the short and long term.

Urbanization

The removal of organic and inorganic carbon dioxide will help to reduce global warming. Massive scale-up, financial investment, and research into ocean and nature-based CDR are all required. The transition to zero-carbon energy sources should also be accelerated.

Science, technology, and innovation for the SDGs

Governments and nongovernmental organisations could form a new global social pact to promote a scientific system that aids in the advancement of peace. The call to strengthen SDG data hubs, partnerships, and data for violence monitoring and enforcement.

Financing to achieve the SDGs

Education and capacity building

While the SDGs reflect global goals, they must be grounded in local support and implementation. Knowledge networks could teach urban and community leaders, practitioners, and philanthropic organisations.

Food systems

To gain a better understanding of the types of data required from cities to track SDG transitions in terms of environmental, social, and economic considerations.

Decarbonization

Studies could look at the current state of achieving the SDGs and how STI can help in the context of the economic crisis, the COVID-19 pandemic, and conflicts such as the war in Ukraine.

Science and peace





- There are 5 Award Categories. Entries must be submitted into the category best described and most relevant to your innovation. If an incorrect category is selected, the Awards Committee reserves the right to disqualify the entry.
- As a guide, Innovation(s) entered for competition must be an innovation /idea /initiative /programme that is/are directly contribute to sustainability, eradicating poverty, improving well-being, protecting our planet, and building peace and prosperity. We understand that certain innovations often serve and impact more than one SDG and participants should choose the category that will benefit the most or most positively impacted by their innovation.

- Entry fees must be made in full upon submission of entries using online banking transfer or via local cheque. Payment is non-refundable.
- Awards entry submissions, interviews and communications between participants and jurors (if any) will be in English. 5.
- The Organiser restricts content which involves nudity, all forms of violence and exploitation, cruelty of animals etc. This restriction is due to the diversity in age and cultural backgrounds of our global audience. All content must be appropriate for a general audience. Any inappropriate content submitted by participants will be duly removed without notice to the participant.

 - a) Synopsis of work/innovation (200 words MS word document)
 - b) Minimum one video (HD 1080p, max 5 mins). A YouTube link is recommended.
 - c) Photo (minimum 1 jpg format, max 2mb)
 - d) Detailed written description of the innovation (PDF about 500 words)
- The online awards submission system allows participants to submit additional supporting documents such as powerpoint presentations and other documents.
- The Organisers reserves the right to the use of photos, videos, synopsis, and write-ups which participants have provided in the online awards submission system for the purpose of the promotion of MTE 2023: SDG International Innovation Awards (SDGIIA) and publicity of your innovation and participation.
- 10. The same entry may be submitted into multiple product categories. If you wish to enter your innovation in more than one category, you will need to repeat the online submission process for every category that you choose. For example, if you are submitting one innovation for 3 different categories, you will be required to make 3 online submissions. An entry fee is applicable for each submission.
- 11. Entries must meet ALL the following requirements BEFORE they are qualified for judging:
 - a) All required sections and fields of the online entry application form are completed.
 - b) All requirements of above item 7 are fulfilled.
 - c) Supported by full payment. Full payment must be made by 25 September 2023.
 - d) Incomplete and unpaid entries will be disqualified. The participant is solely responsible for ensuring that their submission is

complete.

- The jury will evaluate entries submitted in the online submission system. Jurors may request for more information at any time to support validation which might include online interviews, emails or telephone calls.
- The jury's decisions are final and no appeal will be entertained.
- Results will be announced on 20 October 2023 on MTE 2023: SDG International Innovation Awards (SDGIIA) virtual platform. 14
- MTE 2023: SDG International Innovation Awards & Expo (SDGIIA) will take place virtually over 3 days. During this period, visitors will contact participants through our virtual platform via messaging app and email. After the event ends, all innovations will continue to be exhibited virtually for 2 weeks.
